CERTIFIED LEAD RENOVATOR TRAINING CLASS

As of April 22, 2010, if your company engages in remodeling and repair/maintenance, electrical work, plumbing, painting, carpentry, or window replacement that disturbs 6 square feet or more of paint per room inside, or 20 square feet or more on the exterior of a home, child care facility or school built before 1978 then you must have at least one worker from your firm be a certified lead renovator. If you are not familiar with the new guidelines, please visit: www.nahb.org/remodelers OR www.epa.gov to review all the requirements.

Fines can be up to \$32,500 per day, per violation! Can you afford not to comply?

Training will focus on new work practices and important information needed to comply with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Lead-Based Paint, Renovation, Repair, and Painting Program which went into effect April 22, 2010.

Attend the full day training class and receive a certification good for five years.
